

COMMUNITY BBQ TRAILER OVERVIEW

The Fortescue Community BBQ Trailer is available to local community, non-profit and sporting organisations to assist with fundraising and community events. Fortescue will provide BBQ ingredients and materials, along with Fortescue employee volunteers to coordinate the use of the trailer for the event.

What is the Fortescue Community BBQ trailer?

The Fortescue Community BBQ Trailer is a custom-built BBQ and events trailer that was built for Fortescue by WA owned business Shermac Pty Ltd. The trailer has the following features:

- Large, stainless steel plate BBQ
- Two built-in Engel fridges
- Display TV monitor (can be used for organisation logo, menu, pricing or similar)
- Sound system
- Solar-powered lights
- Storage containing trestle tables, BBQ utensils, portashades etc.

Who can apply for the Fortescue Community BBQ trailer?

Non-profit, sporting and recreation and community organised based in Port Hedland can submit an application for use of the Fortescue Community BBQ Trailer.

The delivery, setup, operation and packdown of the trailer will be coordinated by a Fortescue employee (or employees). It is the responsibility of the applicant organisation to identify a Fortescue employee to be the primary contact and coordinator of their event. If you do not have a member or associate of your organisation that is a Fortescue employee, the Fortescue Community team will seek a Fortescue volunteer to be the point of contact and coordinator for the trailer at the event.

All Fortescue employees assisting with the Community BBQ Trailer will be volunteering their time outside of their usual working hours, so approval for use of the trailer will depend on availability of our fabulous Fortescue workforce.

What are the food and drink options available?

There are three BBQ options available - organisations can select from the following:

- Option 1 - BBQ breakfast (bacon and egg sandwiches with BBQ/tomato sauce)
- Option 2 - Sausage sizzle (sausage in a bun with fried onions and BBQ/tomato sauce)
- Option 3 - Hamburgers (traditional hamburger patty in a bun with cheese, tomato, lettuce and BBQ/tomato sauce)

Additional food for special dietary requirements or items not listed above need to be provided by the applicant organisation. If they need to be cooked on the BBQ, please discuss this in advance with the Fortescue volunteer coordinating the event.

Fortescue will provide cold water for the event - if you want to offer soft drinks or juices they will need to be organised and purchased by your organisation.

How long can the trailer be used for, and how often can an organisation apply?

The timing of the event is dependent on the availability of the Fortescue volunteer, as they need to be in attendance for the whole event.

An organisation can only have one trailer application submitted at any time during the calendar year. Once an approved event has been delivered, a new application can be submitted as soon as the acquittal is completed.

All applications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and depend on the resources available to the business at that time.

What is the acquittal process?

Upon receiving confirmation of your application, you will be provided with an Acquittal and Feedback form and instructions for completing the acquittal process.

After the event has passed, the organisation must provide Fortescue with a completed Acquittal and Feedback form to close out the event. This assists Fortescue to track the impact of the Community BBQ Trailer in the community, and see what improvements can be made to the process. Photographs supplied demonstrating the project must be accompanied by a Photographic Consent Form containing written consent from any person featured in the photographs, so they can be used by Fortescue for publicity purposes.
